1. Download the extension from the link below:

- 2. In the main menu of the "Zotero" application, go to Tools > Add-ons
- 3. Select 'Extensions'
- 4. Click on the gear in the top-right corner and choose 'Install Add-on From File...'
- 5. Choose .xpi that you've just downloaded, click 'Install'
- 6. Restart Zotero

<u>IguanaTex</u>

- 1. Download the .ppam file from the following link: <u>http://www.jonathanleroux.org/software/iguanatex/IguanaTex_v1_56.ppam</u>
- 2. Load the add-in:

in "File" > "Options" > "Add-Ins" > "Manage:", choose "PowerPoint Add-Ins" then "Go...", then click "Add New", select the .ppam file in the default Add-In folder or in the folder where you downloaded it, then "Close"

- 3. Create and set a temporary file folder: IguanaTex needs access to a folder with read/write permissions to store temporary files.
 - The default is "C:\Temp\". If you have write permissions under "C:\", create the folder "C:\Temp\". You're all set.
