# Final Project

Your goal in the final project should be to evidence your understanding of the design process and your ability to translate it into action.

## Final Project Paper and Presentation

Although you will be able to provide more detail in your paper than your presentation, both should include:

**Introduction**: Motivate and describe the problem being addressed. (15%)

**Methods and Data**: Describe the process of observation and data collection: why you collected the data you did, how you went about collecting it, and what you found. (30%)

**Design**: Describe the design process and the design. (50%)

**Conclusions and Future Plans**: Summarize the project and briefly describe how to productively proceed. (5%)
