Completing Your Comprehensive Evaluation Requirement

All MSCS and MSSSE students are required to complete a comprehensive evaluation in order to graduate. In the CS Dept., graduate students have five options for completing their comprehensive evaluation:











Master's Thesis

Requires 6 credit hours of CS 6000 - Master's Thesis AND faculty approval

Master's Project

Requires 3 credit hours of CS 6001 - Master's Project AND faculty approval

Master's Report

Requires 3 credit hours of CS 6002 - Master's Report **AND** faculty approval

Industry Career Certificate (Completed through TTU Online partnership with Coursera)
